According to the Yankee Group, 90 % of all organizations are out of compliance with their software license policies, are you one of them? Internet abuse is the leading reason for unproductive time and improper behavior, do you agree? Below are some additional problems and solutions that your organization faces that Resource Monitor™ will solve.

Problem	Solution
I need to report when users begin their work in the morning and leave at the end of the day?	The software automatically captures, by user, when they log in and log out of a computer. Reports are then provided to review how many hours they worked. The software also has an automatic shutdown feature to insure the workstation is turned off at a preset time.
Even though we have enabled limited permissions to stop users from installing software, there is still some software on the Internet, like chat software, which they can still install. How can I stop that from happening?	<p>The software can automatically block any executable from running, including the common file name of setup.exe. Just list what software you do not want them to run and it will be blocked. This feature can be changed on a workstation-by-workstation basis just in case you desire to allow some users to run specific applications.</p> <p>The software also creates an administrative alert every time software is installed or uninstalled.</p>
How can our organization remain software compliant to the licenses that we purchased?	In addition to the automatic software inventory and administrative alerts when software is installed, the software can be configured to use 1 of 5 business rules to react to when licenses are exceeded. For example, one rule is to shut down the application while another is to queue the user until a license becomes available. You can select the business rules, on an application-by-application basis, to fit your desired control.
We have an appliance that monitors our Internet usage but it does not provide accurate usage time for browser and chat software. Can your software provide us with that information?	Yes, our software tracks the total time when the software sits on the desktop as well as when it is active with the keyboard or mouse. For example, an instant messaging program might sit on a users desktop all day but it might actually only be used for a half an hour. The software will provide you with both times so you have accurate information.
How does it help us purchase the correct amount of software licenses to save us money?	By using the actual software usage time (as stated above) for a software application, we can report the utilization, by workstation and user, to determine if software needs to be purchased.
What are the top monitoring tools that are provided by the software?	Although Internet Monitoring seems to be at the top of the list, most of our customers find software tracking and screen captures to be extremely beneficial. All of our monitoring tools can be enabled or disabled by workstation.
How can I make sure that all of our workstations are being updated by Microsoft's Window Update program?	The software inventory feature produces a live inventory when the system starts up and shuts down. This inventory includes all of Microsoft's updates that can be easily viewed or printed to insure systems are up to date.
We prefer to have our users turn off their systems when they leave but that rarely happens. What can we do?	You can configure our software to shut down a system at any predetermined time. Like most features, this can be adjusted on a workstation-by-workstation basis.
